The word, Trinity, actually is not found in the Bible, yet the concept of God existing as one God, but in three persons is revealed throughout the Bible.

Bible Object Lessons on the Trinity

If anyone denies that the Holy Spirit has all power and knows all things, and is everywhere, just as the Father and the Son: he is a heretic. The most extensive declaration of the Church's teaching on the Trinity was made at the Eleventh Synod of Toledo in Spain (675 AD). It is a mosaic of texts drawn from all the preceding doctrines of the Church.

Catholic Doctrine on the Holy Trinity

The Council's definitions concerning the Trinity are really as easy as one, two, three... four. It taught there is one nature in God, and that there are two processions, three persons, and four relations that constitute the Blessed Trinity. The Son "proceeds" from the Father, and the Holy Spirit "proceeds from the Father and the Son."

Explaining the Trinity | Catholic Answers

The doctrine of the Trinity does not divide God into three parts. The Bible is clear that all three Persons are each one-hundred-percent God. The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are each fully God. For example, Colossians 2:9 says of Christ, "in him all the fullness of deity dwells in bodily form."

What Is the Doctrine of the Trinity? | Desiring God

We believe that the one God eternally exists in three Persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit; and that these three are one God, co-equal and co-eternal, having precisely the same nature and attributes, and worthy of precisely the same worship, confidence, and obedience.

Understanding What the Trinity is: Father, Son, Holy Spirit

I think the Trinity is all about God's infinite ability to meet us - each of us, all the time - exactly where we are, with divine understanding that we aren't always in the same place. Our emotional needs change, not just from childhood to adulthood, but in a constant ebb and flow as life challenges and upholds us.

A bright teen asked me to explain the Trinity. Here's what ...

St. Patrick explained the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to his flock in Ireland by using the three leaves of the shamrock. Each leaf represented one of the three persons, but yet it was still only one shamrock. If we take a look at our self, each human is made up of a mind, a body, and a soul, and yet we are still only one person.

Catholic Bible 101 - The Holy Trinity

Trinity means three, so when we discuss the Holy Trinity we mean the Father (God), Son (Jesus), and Holy Spirit (sometimes referred to as the Holy Ghost). Throughout the Bible, we are taught that God is one thing. Some refer to Him as the Godhead. However, there are ways that God has chosen to talk to us.

Patrick the bishop was teaching people about the three Divine Persons in one God. Patrick explained the mystery of the Holy Trinity with a shamrock. He taught them that the shamrock is one plant, but it has three leaves. He compared it to the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit which are not three gods.

Explaining the Holy Trinity - Catechist's Journey

The Christian doctrine of the Trinity (Latin: Trinitas, lit. 'triad', from Latin: trinus "threefold") holds that God is one God, but three coeternal consubstantial persons or hypostases—the Father, the Son (Jesus Christ), and the Holy Spirit—as "one God in three Divine persons". The three persons are distinct, yet are one "substance, essence or nature" ().

Trinity or Ztri-unity (three as one) was a term they developed to try and explain the relationship between God, Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit. This belief in Trinity was later defined in the statement of faith at the Council of Nicaea in AD 325; the Nicene Creed is still repeated by many Christians today in their worship.
